Baseball drops two at Buena Vista

GAME 1:

Buena Vista 9, MLC 2

STORM LAKE, Iowa – The MLC baseball team dropped game one of the double header at Buena Vista 9-2. Starting pitcher Zach Pudlo allowed 14 hits and nine runs (four earned) in six innings. He struck out four and walked one.

The MLC hitters combined for nine hits, led by Tyler Morgan and Justin Hansen, who had two hits apiece. Morgan and Pudlo each had an RBI for the Knights.

Buena Vista's top four hitters went a combined 10 for 16 on the day, scoring six runs and driving home four in the win.

Buena Vista 25, MLC 1

STORM LAKE, Iowa – The MLC baseball team lost game two of the double header at Buena Vista by a score of 25-1.

The Knights allowed eight runs in each of the first two innings, and aided Buena Vista all game with seven errors and nine walks. Brian Polfer got the start for MLC and took the loss.

Offensively, the Knights managed four hits for the game and scratched across the lone run of the game in the Justin Hansen groundout that scored Zach Pudlo from third base.

With the losses, the Knights fell to 0-8 on the season, while Buena Vista improved to 7-1.
