Knights Drop Opener at St. Scholastica

St. Scholastica 14, MLC 2 (seven innings)

DULUTH, Minn. – The MLC baseball team took a 1-0 lead into the bottom of the third inning before the St. Scholastica bats came alive in a 14-2 loss in Duluth Friday night.

The Knights scored in the top of the third inning when a Saint error allowed Jake Scott to score from second base.

After St. Scholastica tied the score in the bottom of the third inning, the Knights held on until the Saints put together two consecutive big innings, scoring seven runs in the fourth and six more in the fifth to put the game out of reach.

Josh Janke got the start and went four innings, struggling with his control as he walked seven to go along with 11 hits as he gave up nine runs. With the loss, he dropped to 2-5 on the season.

With the loss, MLC dropped to 11-24 overall and 7-10 in conference play, while the number three ranked Saints improved to 30-2 and a perfect 18-0 in UMAC action.
