## MLC Drops Two at Luther College

### **GAME 1**

**Luther College 8, MLC 0**

DECORAH, Iowa – The MLC baseball team dropped game one of a non-conference double header at Luther College by the score of 8-0 Sunday afternoon.

The Knights were outhit 12-5 for the game, and ultimately were never able to rebound from a five-run second inning by Luther College, in which they had five hits and sent nine batter to the plate.

Joseph Blum got the start and took the loss, dropping to 3-2 on the season. He went five innings and allowed all eight runs (seven earned), while striking out three.

At the plate, Tyler Morgan led the Knights with two hits, while Justin Krause, Jake Scott and Steve Gurgel had one hit apiece.

### **GAME 2**

**Luther College 17, MLC 3**

DECORAH, Iowa – The Knights took an early 3-0 lead in the top of the first inning, but were unable to hold on as Luther defeated MLC 17-3 in game two.

Andrew Schoenfeld pounded a three-run home run in the first inning, his second homer of the season, to score Mike Haugley and Joe Janke and give the Knights the early lead.

Luther eventually took the lead in the bottom of the fourth, as they scored seven times in the inning. They tacked on six more in the fifth and two in the sixth to finish off the Knights.

Billy King went two and one-third innings for the Knights as the starter before giving way to Hikaru Tomizawa, who took the loss after allowing seven runs (all earned) in one and two-thirds innings of work.

MLC dropped to 9-19 with the losses, while Luther improved to 20-9.
