## MLC Drops Pair to Northwestern

### **GAME 1**

#### **Northwestern 4, MLC 3**

NEW ULM, Minn. – The MLC baseball team jumped on Northwestern with two runs in the first inning, but was unable to hold on in a 4-3 loss to the Eagles Saturday at Mueller Park.

The Knights scored twice in the bottom of the first inning on a long home run by Tyler Morgan that scored Justin Krause, and then took the lead again in the bottom of the third, after Northwestern had scored twice in the top of the inning, when Josh Janke hit a sacrifice fly to score Justin Hansen.

Janke got the start and took the loss, allowing four runs (two earned runs) on eight hits in five innings, dropping his record to 1-3 on the season.

### **GAME 2**

#### **Northwestern 6, MLC 2**

NEW ULM, Minn. – The Knights allowed three runs in the top of the first inning and never could get all the way back in a 6-2 loss to Northwestern in game two.

The Knights had eight hits and numerous chances at the plate, but left ten runners on base for the game.

Joseph Janke led the Knights' hitters with three hits, including two separate RBI singles to drive in both MLC runs.

Joe Janke also started the game, going all seven innings as he dropped to 0-3 on the season. He allowed six runs (all earned) on 11 hits while striking out six.
