Randy Cox Named New MLC Baseball Coach

NEW ULM, Minn. – Martin Luther College is proud to announce that Randy Cox has accepted the position of head baseball coach. Cox replaces Vice President for Administration Steve Thiesfeldt, who served two years as interim coach with a record of 25-42.

Cox brings 17 years of experience as a head baseball coach to the baseball program at MLC. In those 16 seasons, Cox has accumulated a 265-124-2 career record.

For the last 14 seasons, Cox has been the head coach of the varsity baseball team at Michigan Lutheran High School, where he had a career record of 246-117-2. During his tenure at MLHS, Cox guided the program to ten conference championships and six district championships, and produced 16 all-state players. He was also named District Coach of the Year on six different occasions.

Cox's background in athletics dates back to his playing days. After graduating from Lakeside Lutheran High School in Lake Mills, Wis., Cox was a three-time all-conference performer at Dr. Martin Luther College in football and baseball.

"I have a strong passion for the game of baseball, and I am excited to coach the Knights of MLC," Cox said. "I am truly honored and thankful to be offered this position at MLC. I look forward to the challenges and hard work in the off-season conditioning program to develop and maintain a solid baseball program."

Along with his history coaching baseball, Cox also has 18 years of experience coaching football.

Cox will be joining his wife, Rebecca Cox, on the staff at MLC. Last month Rebecca Cox accepted a position to teach in the physical education division and coach volleyball.
